From the moment Daryus Quarles set foot on Hawk Hill in the fall of 2010, he's been an important cog in the Hawks' rotation and an agent of goodwill for the team and the community.

A native of Paulsboro, New Jersey, Quarles sat out his senior season at Paulsboro High School due to New Jersey transfer rules. Quarles spent his freshman and sophomore seasons at Paulsboro, where he averaged 17 points per game as a sophomore, before transferring to Life Center Academy his junior year. When he came back to Paulsboro for his senior year, he was forced to miss the entire season.

It didn't stop Quarles from ultimately finding a great fit at Saint Joseph's and being thrown into the fire immediately as a freshman, when he started every game. It's a rare opportunity for a freshman at any program to come right in and make an immediate impact. Sitting out the previous year didn't deter Quarles from coming in and contributing from day one.

In 33 starts, he averaged more than five points per game, including a season-high 17 points in a win against Norfolk State.

"I definitely relished the opportunity," he said about starting as a freshman. "I sat out my senior year of high school so when I came here I had to do a lot of learning as I went. I definitely wanted to come in and contribute."

After starting and seeing action in all but four games his sophomore season, Quarles has seen his opportunities become more sporadic the last two seasons. After playing 20 minutes per game his freshman and sophomore seasons, he averaged just 10 minutes per game last season.

In 17 games this year, Quarles has averaged three points and just over 13 minutes per game as one of the first guys off the bench. It's a testament to Quarles' growth on and off the court that has kept him hungry and prepared to contribute whenever his name is called.

"Just maturing as a basketball player," he said when asked about what he's worked on most in his four years at Saint Joseph's. "I feel like earlier in my career I used to get upset about not playing as much as I thought I should. Now that I'm older, I don't pout, I just stay ready. I never know when my time may come. When my time comes, I need to be ready to produce."

It's no secret that head coach Phil Martelli seeks out high-character young men during recruitment. Martelli, an active member in various charities, places the utmost importance in community outreach. His team embraces the opportunities, but no one more so than Quarles. When asked about his proudest moment in his four years at Saint Joseph's, he didn't hesitate to talk in depth about the admirable work he and his teammates perform throughout the area. The friends he met at the Kinney Center for Autism and Education and Support hold a special place in his heart.

"Being able to work with kids with autism [at the Kinney Center] has been great," he said. "Just to see the joy that we bring to those kids' faces is a feeling that you can't explain. That's my proudest moment at Saint Joseph's, just being able to give back to those less fortunate."

In addition to their extensive work with the Kinney Center, they've also visited the Hope Lodge of the American Cancer Society and participated in Saint Joseph's Hand in Hand carnival. They band together around the holidays and do a Christmas charity project where they shop for, wrap, and deliver gifts to needy families in West Philadelphia. The players have followed Martelli's lead both on and off the court.

Quarles and his classmates know that this is their last chance to play in the NCAA Tournament. “That’s something I’ve always wanted to experience,” he said. “That means a great deal not only to me, but to my teammates and coaches.”
